**Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of
Settlement and Entry of Scheduling Order**

Plaintiff Diana Mey ("Plaintiff"), on behalf of the Class of individuals she seeks to represent, respectfully submits this Motion for Preliminary Approval of Settlement and Entry of Scheduling Order. As is set forth more fully in the accompanying Memorandum in Support, the Plaintiff and Defendants N.C.W.C., Inc., and Palmer Administrative Services, Inc., (together, the "Settling Defendants," and together with the Plaintiff, the "Parties"), by counsel, have reached a preliminary settlement that is subject to this Court's approval and the terms of which are set out in a written settlement agreement (the "Settlement Agreement"). Plaintiff respectfully submits that the terms of the proposed settlement are fair, adequate, and reasonable, and merit the Court's approval. The Settlement will create a common fund of \$650,000, from which class members will receive a *pro rata* share, after deductions for fees, costs, a class representative incentive award and class administration expenses. Considering the Defendants' financial position, the

risks of continued litigation, and the potential for appellate delay, this is an excellent outcome for class members.

Plaintiff therefore respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order (1) preliminarily approving the terms of the Parties' Settlement Agreement and, and (2) establishing a schedule for effectuating the Settlement. Defendants have agreed to the proposed order of preliminary approval attached to this motion.
